

QUICK FACTS

All public and independent school parent advisory councils (PACs) are eligible to apply for gaming grants.

Amount: PACs receive \$20 per student annually (based on the school's enrollment as of September 30 of the year prior). All district PACs (DPACs) are eligible to receive \$2,500 each year.

Frequency: One application per year – submitted on-line or by mail

Application Period: April 1st to June 30th

Processing Fee: none

Processing Time: As soon as possible in September, but no later than September 30th

Eligible Costs: Include extracurricular enhancements such as sports uniforms, playground equipment, awards/trophies, etc.
